EARLY RELEASE - MAY 23

On Tuesday (5/23), Whiteford is hosting the Tri-County Conference Track & Field Championships that involves seven teams. Competition buses will arrive between 2-2:15pm. Spectators will begin arriving about 2:15pm with the field events starting at 2:45pm. With our current dismissal times, we would have some major traffic and parking issues leading to safety concerns for our students and staff. Transportation for our students will still be provided. 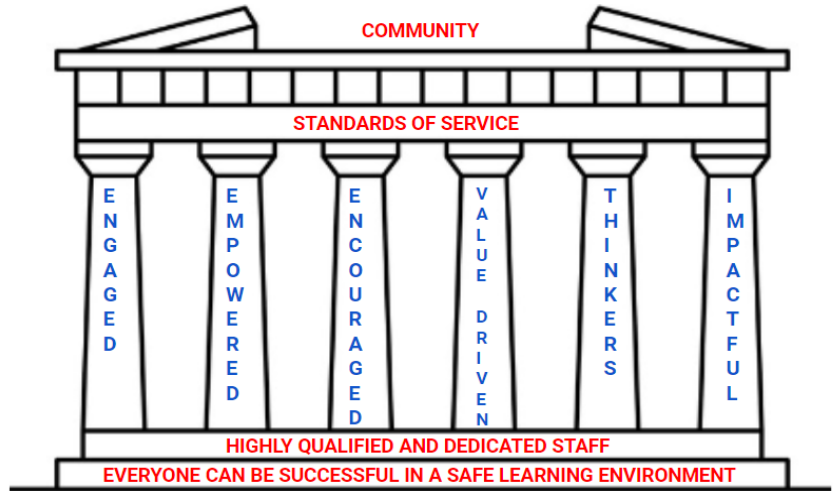
SUBSTITUTES NEEDED
